

## Camp Idlewild of Florida Check-in and Check-out Information

Camp Idlewild has taken new precautions to ensure the safety of our campers, staff and families during the COVID-19 pandemic. We are asking that you follow these simple steps for check-in and check-out. Please help us keep camp safe by following these procedures and being patient during this process. Note: there is a Pre-screen and 4 other stations that are required in order to complete the check-in process.

**<u>Check-In:</u>** (Please arrive at your assigned time)

• The camper will be provided a **SPECIFIC TIME** to arrive to camp in their confirmation packet. (Please do not arrive early, as we are unable to accommodate early check-ins under any circumstances). Upon arrival at Camp Idlewild's main gate, a CIW greeter will direct you to the COVID-19 Pre-screen area. Please make sure that all passengers in the vehicle are wearing a mask throughout the entire Check-in process.

## STATIONS:

- <u>Pre-screen Station</u>- Each passenger will have their temperature checked (touch- free) and the Parent/Caregiver will be required to answer the COVID-19 Questionnaire with our greeter to determine if you/camper can safely complete the check-in process. Please be honest! If you are cleared, you will then proceed to Station #1.
- **<u>Station #1</u>**: Remain in vehicle; a CIW Staff will come to you.
- <u>Station #2</u>: Remain in vehicle; a CIW Staff will come to you
- <u>Station #3</u>: You will be directed by a CIW greeter to unload luggage and belongings, and then proceed to parking area. (1) Parent or Caregiver will be permitted to accompany camper to the medical portion of check-in (Station #3 and Station #4). Both campers and authorized individuals checking in the campers are encouraged to wear a mask.
- <u>Station #4</u>: Please make sure that all of the camper's medications are pre-poured in med minders Please have medication pre-poured in a med-minder box with enough meds for the session. You will also need to bring original pill bottle(s) with one pill for pill verification. Please make sure you provide enough medication or your camper will be sent home and will be unable to attend camp. (Refer to the Pre-pour Medication Instructions).
- Due to COVID precautions, Parents and Caregivers will not be permitted to enter the Camper Cabins during Check-in.
- Please provide a mask(s) for your camper for the whole weekend. We encourage campers and families to wear masks upon arrival and all through the check-in and check-out process.
- During check-in and check-out, please remember to social distance with staff and other individuals as much as you are able.

**<u>Check-Out:</u>** (Please pick-up camper on time to avoid possible late fees)

- A CIW greeter will be outside to direct the Parent/Caregiver to the check-out station under the main pavilion. You will not need to get out of your car. CIW staff will walk your camper and luggage to your car.
- The Camp Nurse will bring all medication and check-out sheets to your car and will answer any questions you may have regarding medical information.
- Please remember we are unable to accommodate late check-outs.
